



New Farms for New Americans (NFNA) ***Volunteer opportunities***

Ongoing:

Photography: Portraits and/or action shots of NFNA trainings/field trips. *Videography* also great.

Graphic Design: Help NFNA staff to create informational and promotional materials

Writing: Complete blogging, article writing and/or development work

Agricultural or Marketing Expertise: Work with NFNA staff to design and deliver a NFNA classroom or on-farm training, or field trip

Spring/Summer:

General Labor: Help move NFNA supplies and equipment on site and set up for summer (May). Help NFNA participants to properly wash, prepare and pack vegetables for wholesale sale/keep records (June-October).

General Support: Assist with seed and plant organization and sales/distribution to participants (May and June)

Driving: Drive the NFNA 15 passenger van 1-4 times a week, bringing people participants to farm and back home. (May-October)

Delivery: Use your vehicle or AALV vehicle to help deliver produce to wholesale and CSA pick up locations. (Mid-June-October)

Mentor a farmer: Help a low-literacy farmer stick to their planting and harvest calendar and properly use supplies and maintain their crops.

Farmers Market Attendant: Help and teach farmers inexperienced with direct sales in the U.S. at local farmers markets (June-mid-October)

Fall:

General Labor: Help clean prepare NFNA farm land for winter, alongside NFNA farmers.

ESL: Experienced ESL teachers needed to deliver agriculture vocational ESL to NFNA participants in classroom or tutor setting.
